- IF A MEDICAL REVIEW COMMITTEE HAS SUBPOENA POWERS AND 18 19 ISSUES A SUBPOENA FOR A PATIENT'S MEDICAL RECORDS FOR MENTAL HEALTH 20 SERVICES AS THE RESULT OF A COMPLAINT RECEIVED BY THE MEDICAL REVIEW 21COMMITTEE FROM A PERSON OTHER THAN THE PATIENT, ON THE SAME DATE
- 22THE SUBPOENA IS ISSUED, THE MEDICAL REVIEW COMMITTEE SHALL NOTIFY

- 1 THE PATIENT BY CERTIFIED MAIL, RETURN RECEIPT REQUESTED, THAT THE
- 2 MEDICAL REVIEW COMMITTEE IS ISSUING THE SUBPOENA FOR THE RECORDS.
- 3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
