- 1 (A) (1) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MAY EMPLOY ONE OR MORE COUNTY ATTORNEYS TO ASSIST IN THE TRANSACTION OF PUBLIC BUSINESS.
- 3 (2) THE SALARY FOR A COUNTY ATTORNEY SHALL BE PROVIDED 4 FOR IN THE BUDGET.
- 5 (B) A COUNTY ATTORNEY MAY BE EMPLOYED BY THE COUNTY 6 COMMISSIONERS TO:
- 7 (1) ADVISE AND COUNSEL THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, 8 COUNTY OFFICIALS, AND COUNTY STAFF IN CONDUCTING THE BUSINESS OF 9 THE COUNTY;
