3 FOR the purpose of repealing obsolete provisions of law pertaining to limitations on
4 the authority of the County Commissioners of Washington County to provide
5 aid to certain factory businesses in Washington County; and generally relating
6 to aid to factories in Washington County.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article 22 – Washington County**

15 [1–107.

16 (a) Subject to the qualifications set forth in this section, the County
17 Commissioners may not spend not more than \$35,000 annually for the following
18 purposes:

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1 (1) To aid and assist any factory in Washington County engaged in the
2 production of goods essential to the defense of the State or nation;

3 (2) To prevent any factory now located in Washington County from
4 moving elsewhere because of inducements offered by any other state, county, or
5 municipality; or

6 (3) To aid and assist any factory to become established in Washington
7 County.

8 (b) All money spent under this section shall be spent only on property which
9 is either owned in fee by the county, or leased by the county for a term of at least 15
10 years.

11 (c) The County Commissioners shall provide in each annual levy an amount
12 equal to the sum to be spent in each year under this section.]

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
14 October 1, 2010.
