### A BILL ENTITLED

#### 1 AN ACT concerning

#### 2 Vehicle Laws – Bicycles, EPAMDs, and Motor Scooters – Rules of the Road

#### FOR the purpose of requiring a driver of a vehicle, when overtaking a bicycle, an EPAMD, or a motor scooter, to pass safely at a certain distance, except under certain circumstances; requiring a driver of a vehicle to yield the right-of-way to a person who is riding a bicycle, an EPAMD, or a motor scooter in a designated bike lane or shoulder under certain circumstances; and generally relating to the rules of the road for bicycles, EPAMDs, and motor scooters.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

### Article – Transportation

17 21–1209.

18 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of this title, the driver of a vehicle19 shall [exercise]:

20 (1) EXERCISE due care to avoid colliding with any bicycle, EPAMD, or 21 motor scooter being ridden by a person; AND

#### HOUSE BILL 461

1 (2) WHEN OVERTAKING A BICYCLE, AN EPAMD, OR A MOTOR 2 SCOOTER, PASS SAFELY AT A DISTANCE OF NOT LESS THAN 3 FEET, UNLESS, AT 3 THE TIME:

4 (I) THE BICYCLE, EPAMD, OR MOTOR SCOOTER RIDER 5 FAILS TO OPERATE THE VEHICLE IN CONFORMANCE WITH § 21–1205(A) OF THIS 6 SUBTITLE ("RIDING TO RIGHT SIDE OF ROADWAY") OR § 21–1205.1(B) OF THIS 7 SUBTITLE ("ROADWAY WITH BIKE LANE OR SHOULDER PAVED TO SMOOTH 8 SURFACE"); OR

9 (II) A PASSING CLEARANCE OF LESS THAN 3 FEET IS 10 CAUSED SOLELY BY THE BICYCLE, EPAMD, OR MOTOR SCOOTER RIDER 11 FAILING TO MAINTAIN A STEADY COURSE.

12 (b) A person may not throw any object at or in the direction of any person 13 riding a bicycle, an EPAMD, or a motor scooter.

14 (c) A person may not open the door of any motor vehicle with intent to strike, 15 injure, or interfere with any person riding a bicycle, an EPAMD, or a motor scooter.

16 (D) UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED IN THIS TITLE, THE DRIVER OF A 17 VEHICLE SHALL YIELD THE RIGHT-OF-WAY TO A PERSON WHO IS LAWFULLY 18 RIDING A BICYCLE, AN EPAMD, OR A MOTOR SCOOTER IN A DESIGNATED BIKE 19 LANE OR SHOULDER IF THE DRIVER OF THE VEHICLE IS ABOUT TO ENTER OR 20 CROSS THE DESIGNATED BIKE LANE OR SHOULDER.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
October 1, 2010.
