14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 (A) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A VARSITY ATHLETICS TEAM 19 FOR A PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL.

(B) (1) THE STATE BOARD, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE MARYLAND
 PUBLIC SECONDARY SCHOOLS ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION, SHALL ADOPT
 REGULATIONS TO ESTABLISH ATHLETIC PARTICIPATION GUIDELINES FOR
 STUDENTS WHO ARE MEMBERS OF A PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETICS TEAM.

1 (2) THE REGULATIONS SHALL INCLUDE PROVISIONS THAT 2 REQUIRE THAT EACH MEMBER OF A PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETICS TEAM 3 PRESENT AT AN ATHLETIC COMPETITION BE ALLOWED TO PLAY IN THAT 4 CONTEST UNLESS THE MEMBER IS INJURED, ILL, OR OTHERWISE UNABLE TO 5 PLAY BECAUSE OF A PHYSICAL OR EMOTIONAL CONDITION.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 October 1, 2010.
