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Student Participation in High School Sports - Academic Requirements

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Board of Education to adopt regulations to 4 establish certain academic performance standards that students in public high 5 schools in the State must meet in order to participate in certain high school 6 athletic competitions; requiring the regulations to include certain provisions; 7 requiring county boards of education to allow certain students to participate in 8 certain high school athletic competitions only in accordance with the regulations 9 of the State Board; and generally relating to academic requirements for student participation in high school sports. 10

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 20 (A) (1) THE STATE BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO 21 ESTABLISH ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE STANDARDS THAT STUDENTS IN PUBLIC 22 HIGH SCHOOLS IN THE STATE MUST MEET IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE IN
- 23 ATHLETIC COMPETITIONS SANCTIONED BY A COUNTY BOARD.

1	(2) THE REGULATIONS SHALL INCLUDE PROVISIONS THAT
2	SPECIFY THE CURRICULUM CONTENT, MINIMUM GRADE POINT AVERAGE, AND
3	GRADE PROGRESS THAT PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS MUST SATISFY TO BE
4	ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN ATHLETIC COMPETITIONS SANCTIONED BY THE
5	COUNTY BOARD.

- 6 (B) A COUNTY BOARD SHALL ALLOW STUDENTS IN PUBLIC HIGH
 7 SCHOOLS IN THE COUNTY TO PARTICIPATE IN ATHLETIC COMPETITIONS
 8 SANCTIONED BY THE COUNTY BOARD ONLY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE
 9 REGULATIONS OF THE STATE BOARD.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2010.
