## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Higher Education – Delegate Scholarships – Summer School**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing a certain provision of law that shortens the term of  
4 certain Delegate Scholarships by a certain amount of time; providing that a  
5 certain award may not exceed one-half the amount of a certain award in an  
6 academic year; and generally relating to using Delegate Scholarships to attend  
7 summer school.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
9 Article – Education  
10 Section 18–505  
11 Annotated Code of Maryland  
12 (2008 Replacement Volume and 2009 Supplement)

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Education**

16 18–505.

17 (a) Each recipient of a full-time Delegate Scholarship may use the  
18 scholarship to attend summer school.

19 (b) [The term of a full-time Delegate Scholarship shall be shortened by  
20 one-half year for each summer of use.

21 (c)] The amount used for summer school may not exceed one-half of the value  
22 of the award for [the next] AN academic year.
