### CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

### 1 AN ACT concerning

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### State Police Retirement System – Special Disability Retirees – Reemployment

4 FOR the purpose of providing that only certain disability retirees of the State Police  $\mathbf{5}$ Retirement System are exempt from a temporary suspension of their disability 6 retirement allowance under certain circumstances; prohibiting certain disability 7retirees of the State Police Retirement System from being rehired by certain 8 employers in certain positions; requiring the Secretary of State Police to provide 9 the Board of Trustees of the State Retirement and Pension System with certain 10 information; providing for a temporary suspension of benefits paid to certain disability retirees under certain circumstances within a certain period of time; 11 12providing for the resumption of disability benefits with certain adjustments to the benefits after receipt by the Board of Trustees of certain documentation 13from the Secretary of State Police; and generally relating to the reemployment 1415of special disability retirees of the State Police Retirement System.

28 29	1. began receiving a disability retirement allowance on or after July 1, 1998; and

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1 2. is employed by a participating employer at an annual 2 compensation that is at least equal to the retiree's average final compensation at 3 retirement.

4 (ii) A temporary suspension under this subsection shall begin as 5 of the date the retiree is reemployed by a participating employer under subparagraph 6 (i)2 of this paragraph.

7 (2) A retiree whose allowance is temporarily suspended under this
8 subsection is not subject to a reduction as provided in § 29–116 of this subtitle during
9 the period of employment by a participating employer.

10 (3) Upon receiving satisfactory documentation that the retiree is no 11 longer employed by a participating employer, the Board of Trustees shall reinstate the 12 retiree's allowance with accumulated cost-of-living adjustments from the date the 13 allowance was temporarily suspended.

14 (4) The retiree's allowance will be reinstated on the first day of the 15 month following the month in which the retiree ceased employment with the 16 participating employer.

18 (A) (1) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO A DISABILITY RETIREE OF THE 19 STATE POLICE RETIREMENT SYSTEM WHO IS RECEIVING A SPECIAL DISABILITY 20 RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE UNDER § 29–111 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

21(2)THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A DISABILITY RETIREE OF22THE STATE POLICE RETIREMENT SYSTEM WHO IS RECEIVING A SPECIAL23DISABILITY RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE UNDER § 29–111 OF THIS SUBTITLE AND24IS REEMPLOYED AS A SHERIFF.

(B) A DISABILITY RETIREE DESCRIBED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS
SECTION MAY NOT BE REEMPLOYED BY A PARTICIPATING EMPLOYER OF THE
STATE OR ANY POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE IN A POSITION IN WHICH
THE DISABILITY RETIREE, IN AN OFFICIAL CAPACITY, IS AUTHORIZED BY LAW
TO MAKE ARRESTS.

30 (C) THE SECRETARY OF STATE POLICE SHALL REPORT TO THE BOARD
31 OF TRUSTEES ANY DISABILITY RETIREE DESCRIBED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF
32 THIS SECTION WHO IS REEMPLOYED BY A PARTICIPATING EMPLOYER OF THE
33 STATE OR ANY POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE IN A POSITION WHERE
34 THE DISABILITY RETIREE, IN AN OFFICIAL CAPACITY, IS AUTHORIZED BY LAW
35 TO MAKE ARRESTS.

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1 (D) (1) WITHIN 30 DAYS OF RECEIVING NOTICE FROM THE 2 SECRETARY OF STATE POLICE AS PROVIDED UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS 3 SECTION, THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES SHALL, AFTER GIVING NOTICE TO THE 4 DISABILITY RETIREE, TEMPORARILY SUSPEND THE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE 5 OF THE DISABILITY RETIREE.

6 (2) BOARD TRUSTEES AFTER THE OF HAS RECEIVED 7SATISFACTORY DOCUMENTATION FROM THE SECRETARY OF STATE POLICE THAT THE DISABILITY RETIREE IS NO LONGER EMPLOYED BY A PARTICIPATING 8 9 EMPLOYER OF THE STATE OR ANY POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE IN A 10 POSITION WHERE THE DISABILITY RETIREE, IN AN OFFICIAL CAPACITY, IS AUTHORIZED BY LAW TO MAKE ARRESTS, THE BOARD SHALL REINSTATE THE 11 DISABILITY RETIREE'S ALLOWANCE WITH ACCUMULATED COST-OF-LIVING 1213ADJUSTMENTS FROM THE DATE THE ALLOWANCE WAS TEMPORARILY 14SUSPENDED.

15 (3) THE RETIREE'S ALLOWANCE SHALL BE REINSTATED ON THE 16 FIRST DAY OF THE MONTH FOLLOWING THE MONTH IN WHICH THE DISABILITY 17 RETIREE CEASED EMPLOYMENT BY A PARTICIPATING EMPLOYER OF THE STATE 18 OR ANY POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE IN A POSITION IN WHICH THE 19 DISABILITY RETIREE, IN AN OFFICIAL CAPACITY, IS AUTHORIZED BY LAW TO 20 MAKE ARRESTS.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 22 July 1, 2010.
