SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 1 2 MARYLAND. That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 3 **Article – Transportation** 4 11-154."School vehicle" means, except as provided in subsection (b) of this 5 (a) section, any motor vehicle that: 6 7 Is used regularly for the exclusive transportation of children, 8 students, or teachers for educational purposes or in connection with a school activity; 9 and 10 **(2)** Is either: A Type I school vehicle, as defined in this subtitle; or 11 (i) 12 A Type II school vehicle, as defined in this subtitle. (ii) "School vehicle" does not include: (b) 13 A privately owned vehicle while it is carrying members of its 14 15 owner's household and not operated for compensation; or 16 A vehicle that is registered as a Class M (multipurpose) vehicle 17 under § 13–937 of this article or a Class A (passenger) vehicle under § 13–912 of this article and used to transport children between one or more schools or licensed child 18 19 care centers or to and from designated areas that are approved by the Administration 20 if: 21 The vehicle is designed for carrying 15 persons or less, (i) 22including the driver; 23 The children are permitted to embark or exit the vehicle (ii) 24 only at a school or child care center or a designated area approved by the 25 Administration: 26 (iii) The owner has obtained vehicle liability insurance or other 27 security as required by Title 17 of this article; and

The vehicle is equipped with proper seat belts or safety seats

so as to permit each child to be secured in a seat belt or a safety seat as required by §§

1	(a) "Type I school vehicle" means a school vehicle that:
2	(1) Is designed and constructed to carry passengers;
3 4	(2) Is either of the body–on–chassis type construction or integral typ construction; and
5 6	(3) Has a gross vehicle weight of more than 15,000 pounds and provides a minimum of 13 inches of seating space per passenger.
7 8 9	(b) "Type I school vehicle" does not include any bus operated by a common carrier under the jurisdiction of a State, regional, or federal regulatory agency of operated by the agency itself.

11 12 13 14 15	Every motor vehicle that is used by nursery schools, camps, day nurseries, of day care centers for children with an intellectual disability to transport children [and that is not regulated as a "school bus" under this article,] shall be equipped with sea belts for each seat and shall be subject to any other regulations adopted by the Administration, UNLESS THE MOTOR VEHICLE:
16	(1) IS A TYPE I SCHOOL VEHICLE; OR
17	(2) WAS FORMERLY REGISTERED AS A TYPE I SCHOOL VEHICLE.
