## A BILL ENTITLED

#### 1 AN ACT concerning

2 Prince George's County – Alcoholic Beverages – Entertainment Permit

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Board of License Commissioners for Prince  $\mathbf{5}$ George's County to issue a certain entertainment permit to holders of Class B 6 licenses; specifying that the permit allows the holder to impose a cover charge, 7 offer facilities for patron dancing, and provide entertainment during a certain 8 period; requiring an applicant for a permit to submit certain evidence to the 9 Board; requiring a holder of a permit to implement a certain security plan and 10 prohibit underage individuals on the premises; providing for an annual permit fee; requiring the Board to adopt certain regulations; and generally relating to 11 entertainment permits in Prince George's County. 12

2	(r) (1) (i) This subsection applies only in Prince George's County.
3 4 5	(18) (I) THERE IS A 7-DAY SPECIAL ENTERTAINMENT PERMIT THAT THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY ISSUE TO A HOLDER OF ANY CLASS B (ON-SALE) LICENSE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS PARAGRAPH.
6 7 8	(II) THE PERMIT AUTHORIZES THE HOLDER AFTER 9 P.M. AND UNTIL 2 A.M. THE FOLLOWING DAY TO IMPOSE A COVER CHARGE, OFFER FACILITIES FOR PATRON DANCING, AND PROVIDE ENTERTAINMENT.
9 10	(III) BEFORE BEING ISSUED A PERMIT, AN APPLICANT SHALL SUBMIT EVIDENCE TO THE SATISFACTION OF THE BOARD THAT THE APPLICANT:
11	1. HOLDS A CLASS B (ON-SALE) LICENSE;
12 13 14	2. HAS DEVELOPED AN ADEQUATE SECURITY PLAN TO PREVENT THE PREMISES FOR WHICH THE PERMIT IS SOUGHT TO POSE A THREAT TO THE PEACE AND SAFETY OF THE SURROUNDING AREA; AND
15 16	3. MEETS ALL OTHER PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY PERMIT REQUIREMENTS.
17	(IV) A HOLDER OF THE PERMIT:
18	1. SHALL IMPLEMENT THE SECURITY PLAN; AND
19 20	2. MAY NOT ALLOW AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS UNDER THE AGE OF 21 YEARS ON THE PREMISES FOR WHICH THE PERMIT IS ISSUED.
21 22	(V) THE ANNUAL FEE FOR THE PERMIT IS \$1,500, WHICH IS IN ADDITION TO THE ANNUAL FEE FOR THE CLASS B LICENSE.
$\frac{23}{24}$	(VI) THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS PARAGRAPH.
