3 (4) A WINERY IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY THAT APPLIES FOR 4 A CLASS A/CLASS 4 LICENSE IS EXEMPT FROM ANY QUOTAS ESTABLISHED BY 5 THE PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS AS TO 6 THE NUMBER OF LICENSES IN THE ELECTION DISTRICT WHERE THE WINERY IS 7 LOCATED.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 July 1, 2010.
