5 (3) A winery in Baltimore County that applies for a Class A/Class 4 6 license is exempt from any quotas established by the Baltimore County Board of 7 License Commissioners as to the number of licenses in the election district where the 8 winery is located.

9 (4) A WINERY IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY THAT APPLIES FOR 10 A CLASS A/CLASS 4 LICENSE IS EXEMPT FROM ANY QUOTAS ESTABLISHED BY 11 THE PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS AS TO 12 THE NUMBER OF LICENSES IN THE ELECTION DISTRICT WHERE THE WINERY IS 13 LOCATED.
