## A BILL ENTITLED

### 1 AN ACT concerning

 $\mathbf{2}$ Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission – Local Small Business 3 **Enterprise Program – Eligibility Criteria PG/MC 114-10** 4  $\mathbf{5}$ FOR the purpose of altering the eligibility criteria of the local small business 6 enterprise program of the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission; and 7 generally relating to the eligibility criteria of the local small business enterprise 8 program of the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission. 9 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, 10 Article 29 – Washington Suburban Sanitary District Section 3–110 11 Annotated Code of Maryland 12(2003 Replacement Volume and 2009 Supplement) 13SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 1415MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article 29 - Washington Suburban Sanitary District 16 3-110.1718 By resolution or regulation, the WSSC may implement a local (a) (1)19small business enterprise program. 20(2)The Office of Small, Local, and Minority Business Enterprise, established under § 3-109(b)(2) of this subtitle, shall administer the local small 2122business enterprise program established under paragraph (1) of this subsection.

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1 (b) The purpose of the program is to assist small businesses that are located 2 in Montgomery County and Prince George's County through the establishment of a 3 sheltered market or other appropriate preference or assistance involving the award of 4 construction contracts or the procurement of goods and services by the WSSC.

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(c) The WSSC shall adopt:

6 (1) Eligibility criteria for businesses to qualify for the local small 7 business enterprise program, including:

8 (i) The criteria for a small business qualifying under the State 9 Small Business Preference Program as established in regulations adopted by the 10 Department of General Services under § 14–203 of the State Finance and Procurement 11 Article;

(ii) A principal place of business in Montgomery County or
Prince George's County [or a significant employee presence in Montgomery County or
Prince George's County with no less than 25% of the business's total number of
employees being domiciled in Montgomery County or Prince George's County]; and

16 (iii) Any other eligibility criteria that the WSSC determines to be 17 necessary or otherwise appropriate for the promotion of local small businesses in its 18 service area; and

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(2) Administrative procedures for conducting the program.

20 (d) A business enterprise may qualify as a local small business for purposes
21 of the program without regard to the race, ethnicity, or gender of the participants in
22 the business enterprise.

(e) The WSSC shall establish graduation criteria from the program for local
 small businesses that the WSSC determines no longer require the assistance or
 benefits offered by the program.

(f) The WSSC shall review the eligibility criteria and administrative
 procedures of the program each year to assess their effectiveness in furthering the
 purposes of the program.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 October 1, 2010.

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
