BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – State Finance and Procurement Section 11–203(a)(1)(xvii) and (xviii) Annotated Code of Maryland (2009 Replacement Volume) BY adding to Article - State Finance and Procurement Section 11-203(a)(1)(xix)Annotated Code of Maryland (2009 Replacement Volume)
