3 FOR the purpose of altering the eligibility for the Janet L. Hoffman Loan Assistance 4 Repayment Program in a certain manner; establishing the Maryland Lawyer 5 Loan Assistance Repayment Program Fund; requiring lawyers to pay a certain 6 annual fee to the Fund; requiring all fees received to be used for a certain 7 purpose; requiring the Office of Student Financial Assistance of the Maryland 8 Higher Education Commission to provide a certain list to the Court of Appeals; requiring the list to be provided free of charge and to contain certain 9 10 information; providing for the purpose and composition of the Fund and expenditures from the Fund; specifying that money in the Fund shall be used by 11 12 the Office to administer the Maryland Lawyer Loan Assistance Repayment 13 Program; establishing the Program; requiring the Office to assist in the 14 repayment of certain loans owed by certain lawyers using certain funds; 15 providing that certain money may not transfer or revert to the General Fund of the State but shall remain in the Fund for a certain purpose; requiring the 16 17 Office to adopt certain regulations; making certain conforming changes; defining certain terms; and generally relating to loan assistance repayment for 18 19 lawyers.
