- 1 AN ACT concerning
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Blue Ribbon Commission on Maryland Transportation Funding

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing a Blue Ribbon Commission on Maryland 4 Transportation Funding; requiring the Commission to review, evaluate, and $\mathbf{5}$ make recommendations concerning certain issues; specifying the membership 6 and staffing of the Commission; requiring the Governor to designate the chair of 7 the Commission; prohibiting members of the Commission from receiving certain 8 compensation, but authorizing the reimbursement of certain expenses; 9 requiring the Commission to submit an interim and final report of its findings 10 and recommendations by certain dates; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to the Blue Ribbon Commission on Maryland 11 Transportation Funding. 12
- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That:
- 15 (a) There is a Blue Ribbon Commission on Maryland Transportation16 Funding.
- 17 (b) The Commission shall review, evaluate, and make recommendations 18 concerning:
- 19 (1) the current State funding sources and structure of the Maryland20 Transportation Trust Fund;
