system for the regulation of domestic animals, including dogs, and wild animals heldin captivity, within the county, including licensing and control.

3 (c) These regulations may include: Provisions for the impoundment and disposal of unlicensed or 4 (1) $\mathbf{5}$ dangerous dogs; Provisions for the regulation of persons who own or keep any 6 (2)7 animal which disturbs the peace and quiet of a neighborhood, or which is vicious; and 8 Reasonable penalties for violations of any of the provisions of the (3)9 regulations, not to exceed imprisonment in the county jail for 30 days or a fine of \$500, or both. 10 11 (d) The county commissioners: 12(1)May regulate animals that are hybrids of domestic or wild animals; 13but 14(2)May not regulate or control wild animals that are not owned or kept by individuals. 15SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 1617October 1, 2010.
