BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 17 Article - Environment 18 19 9-724.20 (c) (1) The political subdivision shall send bills for water service 21[quarterly or twice a year to] TO EACH PROPERTY OWNER FOR each property served 22ON A MONTHLY, QUARTERLY, OR SEMIANNUAL BASIS.

$\frac{1}{2}$	(2) The bills are payable at the office of the political subdivision on receipt.
3 4	(3) If any bill remains unpaid after 30 days from the date the bill is sent, the political subdivision shall:
5 6	(i) Notify the owner of the property served, in writing, that the bill is in arrears and that water service will be discontinued;
7 8	(ii) Leave the notice on the owner's property or mail the notice to the last known address of the owner; and
9 10 11 12	(iii) Discontinue water service to the property until the owner pays the bill and a reconnection charge reasonably related to the cost of reconnection, as established by ordinance of the governing body of the county or municipal corporation in which the water service is provided.
13 14	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2010.
