### 1 AN ACT concerning

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## Environment – Water Service – <del>Property Owners</del> <u>Billing</u>

FOR the purpose of clarifying that a political subdivision shall send a bill for water
 service to each the property, the property owner, or the property owner's
 designee for each property served on a monthly, quarterly, or semiannual basis;
 and generally relating to bills for water service.

## 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 19 Article Environment
- $20 \quad 9-724.$

#### HOUSE BILL 812

(c) (1) The political subdivision shall send bills for water service
 [quarterly or twice a year to] TO EACH THE PROPERTY, THE PROPERTY OWNER,
 OR THE PROPERTY OWNER'S DESIGNEE FOR each property served ON A MONTHLY,
 QUARTERLY, OR SEMIANNUAL BASIS.

5 (2) The bills are payable at the office of the political subdivision on 6 receipt.

- 7 (3) If any bill remains unpaid after 30 days from the date the bill is 8 sent, the political subdivision shall:
- 9 (i) Notify the owner of the property served, in writing, that the 10 bill is in arrears and that water service will be discontinued;
- (ii) Leave the notice on the owner's property or mail the noticeto the last known address of the owner; and
- (iii) Discontinue water service to the property until the owner
  pays the bill and a reconnection charge reasonably related to the cost of reconnection,
  as established by ordinance of the governing body of the county or municipal
  corporation in which the water service is provided.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effectOctober 1, 2010.
