2 State Government - Notary Public - Requirements

- FOR the purpose of requiring that a notary public be a United States citizen; requiring that an applicant for notary public submit proof of citizenship with the application; specifying the types of documents that establish proof of United States citizenship; and generally relating to the requirements for notary public.

- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 14 Article State Government

- Each individual appointed as a notary public shall:
- 17 (1) be at least 18 years old;
- 18 (2) be of good moral character and integrity;
- 19 (3) live or work in the State;
- 20 (4) if living in the State, be a resident of the senatorial district from 21 which appointed; [and]



- 1 if living outside the State, be a resident of a state that allows (5)2 Maryland residents working in that state to serve as notaries public in that state; AND 3 **(6)** BE A UNITED STATES CITIZEN. 4 18–103. An application for original appointment as a notary public shall be 5 (a) (1) made on forms prepared by the Secretary of State and shall be sworn to by the 6 7 applicant. An application by a resident of the State shall bear or be 8 9 accompanied by the written approval of a Senator representing the senatorial district and subdistrict in which the applicant resides or, if that office is vacant, by any 10 11 Senator's written approval. 12 An application by an out-of-state individual shall bear or be 13 accompanied by the written approval of a Maryland State Senator. 14 TO ESTABLISH THAT THE APPLICANT IS A UNITED STATES CITIZEN AS REQUIRED UNDER § 18–102 OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE APPLICANT 15 SHALL SUBMIT WITH THE APPLICATION FOR APPOINTMENT AS A NOTARY 16 **PUBLIC:** 17 18 (I)A COPY OF A BIRTH CERTIFICATE OR VERIFICATION OF BIRTH IN THE UNITED STATES OR A TERRITORY OF THE UNITED STATES; 19 20A CURRENT OR EXPIRED PASSPORT ISSUED BY THE (II)UNITED STATES OR A TERRITORY OF THE UNITED STATES; OR 2122(III) A COPY OF THE DOCUMENT ISSUED BY THE UNITED 23STATES GOVERNMENT IDENTIFYING THE APPLICANT AS A NATURALIZED 24CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES.
- [(4)] (5) Completed applications shall be filed with the Secretary of State.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2010.
