A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Property Tax Credit – Habitat for Humanity

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore City or the 4 governing body of a county or municipal corporation to grant, by law, a property $\mathbf{5}$ tax credit against the county or municipal corporation property tax imposed on 6 certain real property owned by Habitat for Humanity; requiring Habitat for 7 Humanity to submit an annual report to certain governing bodies under certain 8 circumstances; authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore City or the 9 governing body of a county or municipal corporation to set, by law, the amount, terms, scope, and duration of the tax credit and to provide for any other 10 provision necessary to carry out the tax credit; providing for the application of 11 12this Act; and generally relating to authorization for a property tax credit for certain real property owned by Habitat for Humanity. 13

23(A) THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE CITY OR THE24GOVERNING BODY OF A COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION MAY GRANT, BY

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LAW, A PROPERTY TAX CREDIT UNDER THIS SECTION AGAINST THE COUNTY OR
 MUNICIPAL CORPORATION PROPERTY TAX THAT IS IMPOSED ON REAL
 PROPERTY THAT IS:

4 (1) OWNED BY HABITAT FOR HUMANITY WITH THE INTENTION 5 OF RELINQUISHING OWNERSHIP IN THE IMMEDIATE FUTURE;

6 (2) USED EXCLUSIVELY FOR THE PURPOSE OF REHABILITATION 7 AND TRANSFER TO A PRIVATE OWNER; AND

8 (3) NOT OCCUPIED BY ADMINISTRATIVE OR WAREHOUSE 9 BUILDINGS OWNED BY HABITAT FOR HUMANITY.

10 (B) IF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE CITY OR THE 11 GOVERNING BODY OF A COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION GRANTS A 12 PROPERTY TAX CREDIT UNDER THIS SECTION, HABITAT FOR HUMANITY SHALL 13 SUBMIT AN ANNUAL WRITTEN REPORT TO THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF 14 BALTIMORE CITY OR THE GOVERNING BODY OF A COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL 15 CORPORATION GRANTING THE TAX CREDIT DOCUMENTING:

16(1) ALL OF HABITAT FOR HUMANITY'S REAL PROPERTY17HOLDINGS IN THE JURISDICTION GRANTING THE TAX CREDIT; AND

18(2)ALL TRANSACTIONS INVOLVING HABITAT FOR HUMANITY'S19REAL PROPERTY HOLDINGS IN THE JURISDICTION GRANTING THE TAX CREDIT.

20 (C) THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE CITY OR THE 21 GOVERNING BODY OF A COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION MAY, BY LAW:

22(1) SET THE AMOUNT, TERMS, SCOPE, AND DURATION OF A23CREDIT GRANTED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION; AND

24(2)ADOPT ANY PROVISION NECESSARY TO ADMINISTER A CREDIT25GRANTED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
June 1, 2010, and shall be applicable to all taxable years beginning after June 30,
2010.

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
