FOR the purpose of repealing certain provisions of law specifying the membership of $\mathbf{5}$ 6 the Montgomery County Republican Party Central Committee; altering the 7 membership criteria for the Montgomery County Democratic Party Central 8 Committee; requiring certain Democratic Party Central Committee members to 9 be elected in a certain manner and limiting the number of members elected at large that may reside in the same legislative district; making stylistic changes; 10 providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to the 11 12membership of the Montgomery County Republican and Democratic Party 13Central Committee committees.

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall apply to 15 the election for the members of the Montgomery County Republican <u>and Democratic</u> 16 Party Central <u>Committee</u> <u>committees</u> that is held at the primary election on 17 September 14, 2010.

18 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect19 June 1, 2010.
