20 21	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 1 (g) (1) "Law enforcement agency" means a law enforcement agency of a department, county, or municipal corporation of the State.
- 3 (2) "Law enforcement agency" includes:
- 4 (i) sheriffs; and
- 5 (ii) similar agencies of other states and the United States.

- 9 (2) "LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN 10 § 2–101 OF THIS ARTICLE.
- "MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING" MEANS A WRITTEN 11 AGREEMENT ENTERED INTO BY THE ATTORNEY GENERAL OF THE UNITED 12STATES AND THE STATE OR A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE AS A PART 13 14 OF THE UNITED STATES IMMIGRATION AND CUSTOMS ENFORCEMENT 15 AGENCY'S 287(G) DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY PROGRAM UNDER § 287(G) OF THE IMMIGRATION AND NATIONALITY ACT BY WHICH A LAW ENFORCEMENT 16 OFFICER OF THE STATE OR A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE MAY 17 CARRY OUT THE FUNCTIONS OF AN IMMIGRATION OFFICER AS TO THE 18 19 INVESTIGATION, APPREHENSION, OR DETENTION OF ALIENS WHO ARE NOT 20 LAWFULLY PRESENT IN THE UNITED STATES.
- 21 (B) EACH LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY IN THE STATE SHALL ENTER 22 INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING.
- (c) Each law enforcement agency in the State shall provide APPROPRIATE TRAINING IN FEDERAL IMMIGRATION LAW TO EACH LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER THAT WILL BE PERFORMING IMMIGRATION ENFORCEMENT UNDER A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2010.
