State Retirement and Pension System – Retiree Organizations – Direct Mailings

4 FOR the purpose of providing that certain retiree organizations may make a certain 5 number of annual requests to the Board of Trustees of the State Retirement and 6 Pension System for certain member and retiree information that is necessary 7 for certain direct mailings by the retiree organizations; prohibiting certain 8 retiree organizations from including certain information in certain direct 9 mailings; requiring the Board of Trustees to provide certain retiree 10 organizations with certain information subject to certain agreements; requiring certain retiree organizations to provide certain supplies required for certain 11 12 direct mailings and to pay certain costs with regard to those direct mailings; 13 providing that the Board of Trustees is not liable for certain information 14 included in certain direct mailings; defining a certain term; and generally relating to direct mailings by retiree organizations to members and retirees of 15 the State Retirement and Pension System. 16

- 22 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 23 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
 - Article State Personnel and Pensions
- 25 **21–128.**

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- 1 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "RETIREE ORGANIZATION" MEANS AN ORGANIZATION IN WHICH STATE RETIREES PARTICIPATE AND THAT HAS AS ONE OF ITS PRIMARY PURPOSES REPRESENTING OR PROVIDING SERVICES TO STATE RETIREES.
 - (B) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO ANY RETIREE ORGANIZATION THAT HAS:
- 6 (1) THE LEGAL AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE SERVICES TO RETIREES 7 OF THE SEVERAL SYSTEMS; AND
- 8 (2) MEMBERSHIP DUES DEDUCTED FROM MONTHLY BENEFIT 9 PAYMENTS MADE BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES TO A RETIREE OF THE SEVERAL 10 SYSTEMS.
- 11 (C) (1) A RETIREE ORGANIZATION MAY SUBMIT TWO REQUESTS
 12 ANNUALLY TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES TO ASSIST THE RETIREE
 13 ORGANIZATION IN PERFORMING DIRECT MAILINGS TO MEMBERS AND RETIREES
 14 OF THE SEVERAL SYSTEMS WHO ARE MEMBERS OF THE RETIREE ORGANIZATION
 15 OR ELIGIBLE TO BECOME MEMBERS OF THE RETIREE ORGANIZATION.
- 16 (2) THE DIRECT MAILINGS MAY NOT BE FOR THE PURPOSE OF
 17 SUPPORTING OR OPPOSING ANY POLITICAL PARTY, BALLOT MEASURE, OR
 18 CANDIDATE IN ANY ELECTION, INCLUDING ANY STATE GENERAL OR PRIMARY
 19 ELECTION OR ANY ELECTION WITHIN THE RETIREE ORGANIZATION.
- 20 (3) THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES SHALL PROVIDE THE RETIREE
 21 ORGANIZATION WITH RETIREE DATA FOR ADDRESSING ENVELOPES TO THE
 22 MAIL CENTER UNDER A SECURE DATA SHARE AGREEMENT WITH THE MAIL
 23 CENTER UNDER WHICH NEITHER THE RETIREE ORGANIZATION NOR ANY OTHER
 24 ENTITY HAS DIRECT ACCESS TO ANY NAMES OR ADDRESSES.
- (D) THE DIRECT MAILING SHALL PROVIDE MEMBERS AND RETIREES OF THE SEVERAL SYSTEMS WHO ARE MEMBERS OF THE RETIREE ORGANIZATION OR ELIGIBLE TO BECOME MEMBERS OF THE RETIREE ORGANIZATION WITH INFORMATION THAT EXPLAINS THE SERVICES OFFERED BY THE RETIREE ORGANIZATION.
- 30 (E) (1) THE RETIREE ORGANIZATION SHALL PROVIDE ALL PRINTED 31 MATERIALS TO BE MAILED AND ENVELOPES TO A MAIL PROCESSING CENTER.
- 32 (2) THE RETIREE ORGANIZATION IS RESPONSIBLE FOR PAYING
 33 ALL COSTS FOR GENERATING MAILING LABELS, INSERTING MATERIALS INTO
 34 ENVELOPES, SEALING, LABELING, AND DELIVERING MATERIALS TO BE MAILED
 35 TO A BULK MAIL CENTER OR POST OFFICE.

- 1 (3) THE RETIREE ORGANIZATION IS RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL 2 POSTAGE COSTS INVOLVED FOR THE DIRECT MAILINGS.
- 3 (F) THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES IS NOT LIABLE FOR THE CONTENT OF ANY DIRECT MAILING SENT UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 6 July 1, 2010.
