1 AN ACT concerning

State Retirement and Pension System – Retiree Organizations Organization Direct Mailings

4 FOR the purpose of providing that a certain retiree organizations organization may $\mathbf{5}$ make a certain number of annual requests during a certain period of time to the 6 Board of Trustees of the State Retirement and Pension System for certain 7member and retiree information that is necessary for certain direct mailings by 8 the retiree organizations organization; prohibiting a certain retiree 9 organizations organization from including certain information in certain direct 10 mailings; requiring the Board of Trustees to provide certain retiree organizations mail processing centers with certain information subject to 11 12certain agreements; providing that the procurement of a certain mail processing center is the sole responsibility of a certain retiree organization; requiring a 13 14certain retiree organizations organization to provide certain supplies required 15for certain direct mailings and to pay certain costs with regard to those direct 16mailings; providing that the Board of Trustees is not liable for certain 17 information included in certain direct mailings; defining a certain term; 18 authorizing the Board of Trustees to submit a certain report in a certain manner to the Joint Committee on Pensions; providing that the Board of 1920Trustees is not required to provide certain notice to certain retirees under certain circumstances; and generally relating to direct mailings by a retiree 2122organizations organization to members and retirees of the State Retirement and 23Pension System.
