3 FOR the purpose of requiring that each video lottery terminal in a video lottery facility be operated only by the insertion of a video lottery player card; requiring an 4 5 individual who seeks to obtain a video lottery player card to provide the video 6 lottery operation licensee with certain proof of identification; requiring the 7 licensee to use video lottery player cards to prohibit an individual from playing 8 a video lottery terminal under certain conditions; requiring the State Lottery 9 Commission to adopt certain regulations; and generally relating to video lottery terminals. 10

- 21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 22 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 23 Article – State Government

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- 1 (b) The Commission shall regulate the operation of video lottery (1) 2 terminals in accordance with this subtitle. 3 The Maryland State Lottery Agency shall provide assistance to the Commission in the performance of the Commission's duties under this subtitle. 4  $\mathbf{5}$ This subtitle authorizes the operation of video lottery terminals 6 owned or leased by the State that are connected to a central monitor and control 7 system owned or leased by the State that allows the Commission to monitor a video 8 lottery terminal. 9 (2) The Commission shall provide and operate a single central monitor and control system into which all licensed video lottery terminals must be connected. 10 11 (3) The central monitor and control system shall be capable of: 12 (i) continuously monitoring, retrieving, and auditing the 13 operations, financial data, and program information of all video lottery terminals; 14 allowing the Commission to account for all money inserted (ii) in and payouts made from any video lottery terminal; 15 16 disabling from operation or play any video lottery terminal (iii) as the Commission deems necessary to carry out the provisions of this subtitle; 17 18 (iv) supporting and monitoring a progressive jackpot system capable of operating one or more progressive jackpots; and 19 20 (v) providing any other function that the Commission considers 21necessary. 22The central monitor and control system shall employ a widely 23accepted gaming industry communications protocol to facilitate the ability of video 24lottery terminal manufacturers to communicate with the statewide system. 25 Except as provided in subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph, (5)26 the Commission may not allow a video lottery operation licensee to have access to, or 27 obtain information from, the central monitor and control system.
  - (ii) Only if the access does not in any way affect the integrity or security of the central monitor and control system, may the Commission allow a video lottery operation licensee to have access to the central monitor and control system that allows the licensee to obtain information pertinent to the legitimate operation of a video lottery facility.

- 23 (IV) THE COMMISSION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO
