18	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
19	MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

22	(a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.



- 1 (b) "Compost" means the product of composting in accordance with the standards established by the Secretary of Agriculture under § 6–221 of the Agriculture Article.
- 4 (c) "Composting" means the controlled biological decomposition of organic 5 waste material in accordance with the standards established by the Secretary under 6 this title.
- 7 (i) (1) "Natural wood waste" means tree and other natural vegetative 8 refuse.
- 9 (2) "Natural wood waste" includes tree stumps, brush and limbs, root 10 mats, logs, and other natural vegetative material.
- 11 (s) (1) "Yard waste" means organic plant waste derived from gardening, 12 landscaping, and tree trimming activities.
- 13 (2) "Yard waste" includes leaves, garden waste, lawn cuttings, weeds, and prunings.

- 16 (A) A PERSON MAY NOT USE A PLASTIC BAG FOR THE FINAL DISPOSAL
  17 OF YARD WASTE OR NATURAL WOOD WASTE IF THE YARD WASTE OR NATURAL
  18 WOOD WASTE WILL BE PICKED UP BY A GARBAGE COLLECTOR.
- 19 **(B)** A PERSON MAY USE A PLASTIC BAG TO TRANSPORT YARD WASTE OR
  20 NATURAL WOOD WASTE FOR FINAL DISPOSAL TO A FACILITY WHERE THE WASTE
  21 WILL BE COMPOSTED IF THE PERSON SEPARATES THE WASTE FROM THE
  22 PLASTIC BAG AT THE FACILITY.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2010.
