- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring each county board of education to provide certain 4 students with the telephone number of the Maryland Youth Crisis Hotline in 5 certain ways; requiring certain schools to hold a certain school assembly at a 6 certain time each year; requiring certain students and school personnel to 7 attend a certain school assembly; requiring certain schools to send certain 8 information about the Maryland Youth Crisis Hotline to the parents or 9 guardians of certain students at a certain time each year: providing that a 10 county board is not required to reprint or reissue certain documents in use on the effective date of this Act in order to comply with this Act; and generally 11 12 relating to the distribution of information about the Maryland Youth Crisis 13 Hotline in public schools.
