1 AN ACT concerning

Nutrient Trading – Voluntary Agricultural Nutrient Credit Certification Program

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the State Department of Agriculture to establish $\mathbf{5}$ requirements for the voluntary certification and registration of nutrient credits 6 on agricultural land; establishing certain certification and registration 7 requirements; authorizing the Secretary of Agriculture to suspend or revoke the 8 approval or certification of certain credits under certain circumstances; preserving the authority of the Department of the Environment to establish 9 eligibility and other requirements for use of nutrient offset credits under any 10 State or federal permit or other regulatory program; providing for the 11 12application of this Act; and generally relating to the establishment of 13 agricultural nutrient credit requirements.

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THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FINDS AND DECLARES THAT:

2 (1) VOLUNTARY NUTRIENT TRADING PROGRAMS PROVIDE AN 3 INNOVATIVE AND COST-EFFECTIVE APPROACH TO ENHANCE WATER AND AIR 4 QUALITY AND ACHIEVE ADDITIONAL WATER AND AIR QUALITY BENEFITS; AND

 $\mathbf{5}$ (2) THE AGRICULTURAL NUTRIENT CREDIT CERTIFICATION 6 PROGRAM ESTABLISHED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE AUTHORIZES THE 7 DEPARTMENT TO VERIFY, CERTIFY, AND REGISTER AGRICULTURAL NUTRIENT 8 CREDITS IN SUPPORT OF PRIVATE AND PUBLIC NUTRIENT TRADING ACTIVITIES 9 BETWEEN THE BUYER OF NUTRIENT CREDITS AND THE FARM OWNER OR 10 OPERATOR THAT AGREES TO BE PAID AND IMPLEMENT BEST MANAGEMENT 11 PRACTICES TO REDUCE AGRICULTURAL NUTRIENT RUNOFF AND EMISSIONS.

(A) THE DEPARTMENT MAY ESTABLISH REQUIREMENTS FOR THE
 VOLUNTARY CERTIFICATION AND REGISTRATION OF NUTRIENT CREDITS ON
 AGRICULTURAL LAND, AS DEFINED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF ASSESSMENTS
 AND TAXATION.

17(B) CERTIFICATION AND REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS ESTABLISHED18UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION SHALL INCLUDE:

19(1) APPLICATION AND ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR20CERTIFICATION;

21 (2) STANDARDS FOR QUANTIFYING NUTRIENT CREDITS 22 RESULTING FROM ANY EXISTING OR PROPOSED AGRONOMIC, LAND USE, AND 23 STRUCTURAL PRACTICE;

24(3) REQUIREMENTSGOVERNINGTHEDURATIONAND25MAINTENANCE OF CREDITS; AND

26(4)ESTABLISHMENT OF A CREDIT REGISTRY ACCESSIBLE TO THE27PUBLIC.

ON NOTICE AND OPPORTUNITY TO BE HEARD, THE SECRETARY MAY SUSPEND OR REVOKE THE APPROVAL OR CERTIFICATION OF CREDITS APPLICABLE FOR THE PROGRAM FOR A VIOLATION OF THIS SUBTITLE OR FOR A

1 VIOLATION OF ANY REGULATION ADOPTED BY THE SECRETARY UNDER THIS 2 SUBTITLE.

3 **8–904.**

4 NOTHING IN THIS SUBTITLE IS INTENDED TO SUPPLANT OR LIMIT THE 5 AUTHORITY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENT TO ESTABLISH 6 ELIGIBILITY AND OTHER REQUIREMENTS FOR USE OF NUTRIENT OFFSET 7 CREDITS UNDER ANY STATE OR FEDERAL PERMIT OR OTHER REGULATORY 8 PROGRAM.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the provisions of this Act 10 may not be construed to affect the rights and obligations of any party to any 11 agreement to preserve land for agricultural use under any State, local, or private 12 program for the preservation of agricultural land.

13 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect14 June 1, 2010.
