## Harford County Board of Education - Student Member - Voting Rights

- 3 FOR the purpose of providing that the student member of the Harford County Board 4 of Education has certain voting rights; prohibiting the student member from 5 voting on certain matters; altering certain procedures for the election of the 6 student member; requiring the Harford County Regional Association of Student 7 Councils to conduct a certain nominating convention; altering the qualifications 8 of the student member; providing for the reimbursement of certain expenses of 9 the student member under certain circumstances; and generally relating to the 10 voting rights of the student member of the Harford County Board of Education.
