A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Public Schools – Law Enforcement Officers – Cultural Competency Training Program

FOR the purpose of requiring the State Department of Education, in consultation with 4 $\mathbf{5}$ the Maryland Police Training Commission, to develop and implement a cultural 6 competency training program for certain law enforcement officers; providing for $\mathbf{7}$ the contents of the cultural competency training program; requiring certain law 8 enforcement officers employed by a county board of education to complete the 9 cultural competency training program before beginning a certain assignment; and generally relating to a cultural competency training program for law 10 enforcement officers in public schools. 11

- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
 - Article Education

20 **7–430.**

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(A) THE DEPARTMENT, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE MARYLAND
 POLICE TRAINING COMMISSION, SHALL DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT A
 CULTURAL COMPETENCY TRAINING PROGRAM FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT
 OFFICERS EMPLOYED BY COUNTY BOARDS FOR ASSIGNMENT IN PUBLIC
 SCHOOLS.

1 **(B)** (1) THE CULTURAL COMPETENCY TRAINING PROGRAM SHALL $\mathbf{2}$ TEACH BEHAVIORS, ATTITUDES, AND POLICIES THAT ENABLE LAW 3 ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS TO UNDERSTAND, COMMUNICATE WITH, AND 4 EFFECTIVELY INTERACT WITH THE INDIVIDUALS, ORGANIZATIONS, AND INSTITUTIONS IN THE COMMUNITY IN WHICH THE PUBLIC SCHOOL TO WHICH A $\mathbf{5}$ 6 LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER IS ASSIGNED IS LOCATED.

7 (2) THE CULTURAL COMPETENCY TRAINING PROGRAM SHALL 8 INCLUDE:

9 (I) PERSONAL EXPOSURE TO THE INDIVIDUALS, 10 ORGANIZATIONS, AND INSTITUTIONS WITHIN THE ASSIGNED COMMUNITY; AND

11(II) KNOWLEDGE OF GOVERNMENT AND COMMUNITY12SERVICES AVAILABLE TO HELP PREVENT JUVENILE ARRESTS.

(C) A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER WHO IS EMPLOYED BY A COUNTY
BOARD AND IS ASSIGNED TO PATROL A SCHOOL BUILDING OR SCHOOL GROUNDS
SHALL COMPLETE THE CULTURAL COMPETENCY TRAINING PROGRAM
ESTABLISHED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION BEFORE THE LAW
ENFORCEMENT OFFICER BEGINS AN ASSIGNMENT IN A PUBLIC SCHOOL.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect19 July 1, 2010.
