Baltimore City - Tax Credit - Use of City Recycling Bins

- FOR the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore City to grant, by law, a property tax credit against the county property tax on certain dwellings if the occupant of the dwelling uses certain recycling bins; authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore City to provide by law for the provisions of the tax credit; defining a certain term; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to property tax credits in Baltimore City.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 19 (G) (1) IN THIS SUBSECTION, "OFFICIAL CITY RECYCLING BIN" 20 MEANS A BIN BEARING THE CITY SEAL DESIGNATED BY THE BALTIMORE CITY
- 21 DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AS THE BIN TO BE USED FOR RECYCLING.
- 22 (2) THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE CITY MAY 23 GRANT, BY LAW, A PROPERTY TAX CREDIT UNDER THIS SECTION AGAINST THE



1	COUNTY PROPERTY TAX IMPOSED ON REAL PROPERTY IF THE OCCUPANT OF
2	THE PROPERTY USES OFFICIAL CITY RECYCLING BINS FOR RECYCLING.

- 3 (3) THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE CITY MAY 4 PROVIDE, BY LAW FOR:
- 5 (I) ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR THE CREDIT UNDER THIS 6 SUBSECTION;
- 7 (II) THE AMOUNT AND DURATION OF THE CREDIT UNDER 8 THIS SUBSECTION;
- 9 (III) REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES FOR THE 10 APPLICATION AND UNIFORM PROCESSING OF REQUESTS FOR THE CREDIT; AND
- 11 (IV) ANY OTHER PROVISION NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT THE 12 CREDIT UNDER THIS SUBSECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2010, and shall be applicable to all taxable years beginning after June 30, 2010.
