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## State Government - Open Meetings Act - Online Training

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Open Meetings Law Compliance Board to 4 develop and offer an online training program on the requirements of the open 5 meetings law to employees, officers, or members of a public body; requiring a 6 public body to designate certain individuals to receive certain online training; 7 requiring the public body to submit a list of the individuals designated to 8 receive certain online training to the Board; requiring certain individuals 9 designated to receive certain online training to complete the training within a 10 certain time period; requiring certain individuals to complete certain annual online training; and generally relating to online training on the requirements of 11 12 the Open Meetings Act.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the initial individuals designated under § 10–502.7(b)(1) of the State Government Article, as enacted by Section 1 of this Act, shall complete the online training on the requirements of the open meetings law within 6 months after the effective date of this Act.

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5 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 6 October 1, 2010.
