## Motor Fuel Refiner or Supplier Suppliers - Games of Chance - Repeal of Prohibition

- 4 FOR the purpose of repealing a provision prohibiting a refiner or other supplier of motor fuel to a retail service station from engaging in, sponsoring, promoting, 5 6 advertising, or otherwise performing or participating in certain games of chance 7 that would be marketed or offered to the public at certain retail service stations; 8 repealing a provision authorizing certain suppliers to participate in certain 9 games of chance sponsored by entities other than certain refiners or suppliers of motor fuel; repealing a provision prohibiting certain suppliers from requiring 10 11 certain retail station dealers to pay for certain costs authorizing certain 12 suppliers of motor fuel to engage in, sponsor, promote, advertise, or otherwise perform or participate in certain games of chance at certain retail service 13 stations under certain circumstances; providing that certain suppliers 14 authorized to participate in a game of chance may not require a retail service 15 16 station to participate in the game of chance; providing for the termination of 17 this Act; and generally relating to games of chance and motor fuel refiners or 18 suppliers.

5 6 7 8	(a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, a refiner or other supplier of motor fuel to a retail service station may not engage in, sponsor, promote, advertise, or otherwise perform or participate in a game of chance to be marketed or offered to the public at a retail service station in the State.
9 10 11 12 13	(b) (1) A supplier of motor fuel authorized under this title to operate SUPPLY retail service stations may, at such stations, SPONSOR, PROMOTE, ADVERTISE, OR OTHERWISE PERFORM OR participate in a game of chance promoted or sponsored by entities other than a refiner or supplier of motor fuel IF THE RETAIL SERVICE STATION DEALER AGREES TO PARTICIPATE IN THE GAME OF CHANCE.
14 15 16	(2) A supplier of motor fuel authorized under this section to conduct a game of chance may not require a retail service station dealer to pay for any costs related to PARTICIPATE IN the game of chance.
17 18 19 20	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2010. It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and, at the end of September 30, 2013, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
