12	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13	MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 THE GOVERNOR ANNUALLY SHALL ISSUE AN ORDER, IN OBSERVANCE OF 17 EARTH HOUR, THAT REQUIRES THE LIGHTS OF GOVERNMENT HOUSE AND THE 18 STATE HOUSE TO BE TURNED OFF ON THE LAST SATURDAY IN MARCH AT 8:30 19 P.M. AND TO REMAIN OFF FOR 1 HOUR.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.
