## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning 2 Electric Companies - Residential Rates 3 FOR the purpose of requiring an electric company to apply certain residential rates to certain buildings located in an area zoned for residential use; providing for the 4 5 application of this Act; and generally relating to electric utility rates. 6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, 7 Article – Public Utility Companies 8 Section 7–305 9 Annotated Code of Maryland 10 (2008 Replacement Volume and 2009 Supplement) 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 13 Article - Public Utility Companies 14 7 - 305.15 A gas company or electric company may bill its customers for gas, 16 electricity, or any other service it renders only on the basis of the net total cost of the service under the applicable rate that is filed for that service. 17 18 The Commission may authorize a gas company or electric company to apply an additional charge over the net total cost to any bill or part of a bill that is 19 20 not paid: 21(i) within 20 days for a residential customer or residential 22 cooperative; or 23 within 15 days for any other customer. (ii)

(2) (i) The additional charge that is applied by a gas company or electric company under this subsection may not exceed 5% of the net bill or part of the bill.
(ii) Unless the Commission approves the imposition of different
charges on different classes of customers, any additional charges applied by a gas
company or electric company under this subsection shall be uniform for all customers.
(C) (1) This subsection does not apply to a building located
IN AN AREA ZONED FOR RESIDENTIAL USE THAT IS USED FOR:
TOTAL THE TOTAL DESIDENTIAL COLUMN TO COLD TOTAL
(I) A HOME-BASED BUSINESS; OR
(II) ANY OTHER COMMERCIAL ENTERPRISE.
(2) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS
SUBSECTION, AN ELECTRIC COMPANY SHALL APPLY A RESIDENTIAL RATE
INCLUDED IN ITS FILED TARIFF TO ALL BUILDINGS LOCATED IN AN AREA ZONED
FOR RESIDENTIAL USE, INCLUDING GARAGES AND OTHER BUILDINGS
ANCILLARY TO A RESIDENCE.
SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
October 1, 2010.
