2 Caroline County – Bay Restoration Fee – Lien Against Property

FOR the purpose of establishing in Caroline County that an unpaid Bay Restoration
Fee is a lien against the property on which the wastewater facility, onsite
sewage disposal system, or holding tank is located; requiring a notice of lien to
be recorded in the land records of Caroline County; and generally relating to the
Bay Restoration Fee.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 (d) (1) Subject to the approval of the Administration, a local government 18 or a billing authority for a water or wastewater facility may establish a program to 19 exempt from the requirements of this section a residential dwelling able to 20 demonstrate substantial financial hardship as a result of the restoration fee.
