Business Regulation - Franchises - Copies of Documents to Franchisees

- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a franchisor from selling a franchise in the State without first giving a prospective franchisee a copy of the offering prospectus 4 5 and a copy of each proposed agreement that relates to the sale of the franchise 6 at the earlier of: a certain period of time before the execution of a certain 7 binding agreement, a certain period of time before payment of certain 8 consideration, or at the prospective franchisee's reasonable request to receive a 9 copy of the offering prospectus; and generally relating to providing copies of certain documents to franchisees. 10

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- A franchisor may not sell a franchise in the State without first giving a prospective franchisee a copy of the offering prospectus and a copy of each proposed agreement that relates to the sale of the franchise at the earlier of:
- 23 (1) [the first personal meeting of the franchisor and] 14 CALENDAR 24 DAYS BEFORE THE EXECUTION BY the prospective franchisee [to discuss the possible 25 sale of the franchise; or] OF ANY BINDING AGREEMENT WITH THE FRANCHISOR;



1	(2) [10 business days before the execution of a contract or] 14
2	CALENDAR DAYS BEFORE payment of any consideration that relates to the franchise
3	relationship; OR

- 4 (3) A REASONABLE REQUEST BY A PROSPECTIVE FRANCHISEE TO 5 RECEIVE A COPY OF THE OFFERING PROSPECTUS.
- 6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 October 1, 2010.
