4 5 6	(1) [the first personal meeting of the franchisor and] 14 CALENDAR DAYS BEFORE THE EXECUTION BY the prospective franchisee [to discuss the possible sale of the franchise; or] OF ANY BINDING AGREEMENT WITH THE FRANCHISOR;
7 8 9	(2) [10 business days before the execution of a contract or] 14 CALENDAR DAYS BEFORE payment of any consideration that relates to the franchise relationship; OR
10 11	(3) A REASONABLE REQUEST BY A PROSPECTIVE FRANCHISEE TO RECEIVE A COPY OF THE OFFERING PROSPECTUS.
12 13	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2010.
