12 13	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16	(a) A person may not:
17 18 19	(1) threaten an individual, or a friend or family member of an individual, with physical violence with the intent to coerce, induce, or solicit the individual to participate in or prevent the individual from leaving a criminal gang; OR
20 21 22	(2) SOLICIT, INVITE, RECRUIT, ENCOURAGE, OR OTHERWISE CAUSE OR ATTEMPT TO CAUSE AN INDIVIDUAL TO PARTICIPATE IN A CRIMINAL GANG.



- 1 (b) A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to imprisonment not exceeding 2 years or a fine not exceeding 3 \$1,000 or both.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 5 October 1, 2010.
