15 16	(c) "Criminal gang" means a group or [ongoing] AN association of three or more persons whose members:
17 18	(1) individually or collectively engage in a pattern of criminal gang activity;
19 20 21	(2) have as one of their primary objectives or activities the commission of one or more underlying crimes, including acts by juveniles that would be underlying crimes if committed by adults; and
22 23	(3) have in common an identifying sign, symbol, name, leader, or purpose.
