A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Business Regulation – Returnable Containers – Plastic Secondary Packaging

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting certain persons from purchasing more than a certain number of items of plastic secondary packaging for a certain purpose; requiring 4 $\mathbf{5}$ certain persons that purchase certain plastic secondary packaging to make a 6 certain record of each transaction in which a person sells a certain number of 7 items of plastic secondary packaging; requiring certain purchasers to verify the 8 identity of certain sellers in a certain manner; requiring certain purchasers to 9 keep certain records of certain transactions; requiring certain records to be kept 10 for a certain period of time; providing that a person that violates this Act is guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to a certain fine; defining a certain term; 11 12and generally relating to the purchase of plastic secondary packaging.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Business Regulation

21 **19–308.**

(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION, "PLASTIC SECONDARY PACKAGING" MEANS
A PLASTIC CRATE OR SHELL USED FOR THE BULK TRANSPORTATION, STORAGE,
OR CARRYING OF RETAIL ITEMS.



1 (2) "PLASTIC SECONDARY PACKAGING" INCLUDES MILK CRATES, 2 BAKERY AND SOFT DRINK TRAYS, AND OTHER COMMERCIAL PLASTIC 3 SECONDARY PACKAGING.

4 **(B) O**THER THAN A MANUFACTURER OF PLASTIC SECONDARY 5 PACKAGING, A PERSON MAY NOT PURCHASE FOUR OR MORE ITEMS OF PLASTIC 6 SECONDARY PACKAGING FOR THE PURPOSE OF RECYCLING, SHREDDING, OR 7 DESTROYING THE ITEMS.

8 (C) (1) EACH PERSON THAT PURCHASES AN ITEM OF PLASTIC 9 SECONDARY PACKAGING, INCLUDING A PERSON THAT IS IN THE BUSINESS OF 10 RECYCLING, SHREDDING, OR DESTROYING PLASTIC SECONDARY PACKAGING, 11 SHALL MAKE A WRITTEN RECORD OF EACH TRANSACTION IN WHICH A PERSON 12 SELLS FOUR OR MORE ITEMS OF PLASTIC SECONDARY PACKAGING, THAT SHOWS 13 THAT THE PERSON SELLING THE PLASTIC SECONDARY PACKAGING HAS LAWFUL 14 POSSESSION OR OWNERSHIP OF THE PLASTIC SECONDARY PACKAGING.

15 (2) FOR EACH TRANSACTION SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (1) OF 16 THIS SUBSECTION, THE PURCHASER SHALL:

17 (I) VERIFY THE SELLER'S IDENTITY BY A DRIVER'S LICENSE
 18 OR OTHER GOVERNMENT-ISSUED IDENTIFICATION; AND

19(II) MAKE A RECORD OF EACH TRANSACTION THAT20INCLUDES:

211.THE NAME, ADDRESS, TELEPHONE NUMBER, AND22SIGNATURE OF THE SELLER OR THE SELLER'S AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE;

23 **2.** THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE PURCHASER;

24 3. THE REGISTRATION NUMBER AND LICENSE TAG
25 NUMBER OF ANY VEHICLE USED IN THE DELIVERY OF THE PLASTIC SECONDARY
26 PACKAGING;

274.A DESCRIPTION OF THE ITEMS SOLD, INCLUDING28THE NUMBER OF UNITS; AND

29 **5.** THE DATE OF THE TRANSACTION.

30(D) THE PURCHASER SHALL KEEP THE RECORDS REQUIRED BY THIS31SECTION FOR AT LEAST 1 YEAR AFTER THE DATE OF PURCHASE.

32 (E) A PERSON THAT VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A 33 MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE OF \$100. 1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 October 1, 2010.
