1 AN ACT concerning

2 Business Regulation - Returnable Containers - Plastic Secondary Packaging

FOR the purpose of prohibiting certain persons from purchasing more than a certain number of items of plastic secondary packaging for a certain purpose; requiring certain persons that purchase certain plastic secondary packaging to make a certain record of each transaction in which a person sells a certain number of items of plastic secondary packaging; requiring certain purchasers to verify the identity of certain sellers in a certain manner; requiring certain purchasers to keep certain records of certain transactions; requiring certain records to be kept for a certain period of time; providing that a person that violates this Act is guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to a certain fine; defining a certain term; and generally relating to the purchase of plastic secondary packaging.

MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
