17	(2) "Compensatory damages" means:
18	(i) In the case of the death of a pet, the <b>GREATER OF:</b>
19 20	1. The fair market value of the pet IMMEDIATELY before [death and] the TORTIOUS ACT OR OMISSION THAT CAUSED THE DEATH; OR
21 22	2. The reasonable and necessary cost of veterinary care RESULTING FROM THE TORTIOUS ACT OR OMISSION; [and] OR

1	(ii) In the case of an injury to a pet, the <b>GREATER OF:</b>
2	1. THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE FAIR MARKET
3	VALUE OF THE PET IMMEDIATELY BEFORE THE TORTIOUS ACT OR OMISSION
4	THAT CAUSED THE INJURY AND THE FAIR MARKET VALUE OF THE PET
