# **Board of Public Works – Tax Forgiveness – Authority**

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Board of Public Works, under certain circumstances, to waive any State tax liability owed by an estate if the Department of Natural Resources makes a certain request and the property is to be acquired by a unit of State or local government; authorizing the Department, under certain circumstances, to formally request that the Board waive certain tax liabilities; and generally relating to the authority of the Board of Public Works to waive certain tax liabilities.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

# Article – State Finance and Procurement

18 **10–207.** 

19 (A) IN CONNECTION WITH THE ACQUISITION OF A PROPERTY FROM AN 20 ESTATE, THE BOARD MAY WAIVE ANY STATE TAX LIABILITIES, INCLUDING 21 PENALTIES AND INTEREST, OWED BY THE ESTATE, IF:

(1) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, THE
DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES FORMALLY REQUESTS THE BOARD TO
WAIVE THE STATE TAX LIABILITIES; AND



1 (2) THE PROPERTY IS TO BE ACQUIRED BY A UNIT OF STATE OR 2 LOCAL GOVERNMENT.

3 (B) THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES MAY FORMALLY 4 REQUEST THAT THE BOARD WAIVE THE STATE TAX LIABILITIES UNDER 5 SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION IF THE DEPARTMENT DETERMINES THAT THE 6 PROPERTY TO BE ACQUIRED IS NECESSARY TO PRESERVE OPEN SPACE FOR THE 7 BENEFIT OF NATURAL HABITAT OR THE CHESAPEAKE BAY AND ITS 8 TRIBUTARIES.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 July 1, 2010.
