- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing a Baltimore City Fire Station Closing and 4 Realignment Citizens' Review Board; providing for the membership, terms, and 5 duties of the Board; providing for the chair of the Board; providing that a 6 member of the Board may not receive compensation as a member of the Board 7 but may receive reimbursement for certain expenses; requiring the Board to 8 study the distribution of certain fire stations and fire and rescue services in 9 Baltimore City, hear evidence on fire station closings and fire service 10 realignments in Baltimore City, and make certain recommendations to the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore; making this Act an emergency measure; 11 12 and generally relating to the Baltimore City Fire Station Closing and 13 Realignment Citizens' Review Board.

- 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 23 (A) THERE IS A BALTIMORE CITY FIRE STATION CLOSING AND 24 REALIGNMENT CITIZENS' REVIEW BOARD.

1 (B) THE BOARD CONSISTS OF THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS:

- 2 (1) ONE MEMBER FROM EACH LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT IN
- 3 BALTIMORE CITY, APPOINTED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY
- 4 FOR THAT LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT; AND
- 5 (2) ONE MEMBER APPOINTED BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF
- 6 BALTIMORE.
- 7 (C) THE MEMBER APPOINTED BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF
- 8 BALTIMORE SHALL BE THE CHAIR OF THE BOARD.
- 9 (D) (1) THE TERM OF A MEMBER IS 2 YEARS AND BEGINS ON JUNE 1
- 10 OF THE YEAR OF APPOINTMENT.
- 11 (2) AT THE END OF A TERM, THE APPOINTED MEMBER
- 12 CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
- 13 (3) A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN
- 14 SERVES ONLY FOR THE REST OF THE TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS
- 15 APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
- 16 **(E)** A MEMBER OF THE BOARD:
- 17 (1) MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION AS A MEMBER OF THE
- 18 **BOARD; BUT**
- 19 (2) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE
- 20 STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE
- 21 BUDGET.
- 22 (F) THE BOARD SHALL:
- 23 (1) STUDY THE DISTRIBUTION OF FIRE STATIONS AND FIRE AND
- 24 RESCUE SERVICES IN BALTIMORE CITY:
- 25 (2) HEAR EVIDENCE ON FIRE STATION CLOSINGS AND SERVICE
- 26 REALIGNMENTS IN BALTIMORE CITY; AND
- 27 (3) MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE MAYOR AND CITY
- 28 COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE BASED ON CONVINCING EVIDENCE THE BOARD
- 29 OBTAINS THROUGH ITS STUDY OF AND HEARINGS ON THE CLOSURE AND
- 30 REALIGNMENT OF FIRE STATIONS IN BALTIMORE CITY.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three—fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.
