A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Commission on Responses to Serious Incidents of Inclement Weather

3 FOR the purpose of establishing a Commission on Responses to Serious Incidents of 4 Inclement Weather; providing for the membership and duties of the $\mathbf{5}$ Commission; providing for the staffing of the Commission; requiring the 6 Governor to appoint the chair of the Commission; prohibiting a member of the 7Commission from receiving certain compensation; authorizing a member of the 8 Commission to receive reimbursement for certain expenses; requiring the 9 Commission to report to the Governor and the General Assembly by certain 10 dates; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to the 11 establishment of a Commission on Responses to Serious Incidents of Inclement 12Weather.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That:

15 (a) There is a Commission on Responses to Serious Incidents of Inclement16 Weather.

- 17 (b) The Commission consists of the following members:
- 18 (1) one member of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the President19 of the Senate;
- 20 (2) one member of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker of 21 the House;
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- (3) the Secretary of Transportation, or the Secretary's designee;



1 (4) the State Highway Administrator, or the Administrator's designee: $\mathbf{2}$ the head of the transportation agency in: (5)3 (i) Baltimore City; and 4 (ii) each county in the State; Superintendent of the Maryland State Police, or the $\mathbf{5}$ the (6)6 Superintendent's designee; 7(7)the Executive Director of the Maryland Emergency Management Agency, or the Executive Director's designee; 8 9 (8)the State Superintendent of Schools, or the State Superintendent's designee; 10 11 a representative of the Office of the Attorney General, Consumer (9)12Protection Division, designated by the Attorney General; and 13the following individuals, appointed by the Governor: (10)14(i) a representative involved in educating the public about meteorology; 1516 (ii) a representative of the broadcast and electronic media; 17(iii) a representative of the print media; a representative involved in public disaster emergency 18 (iv) 19response; 20a representative of a public utility company: (v) 21a representative of an automobile safety association that (vi) 22conducts business in the State; 23(vii) a representative of a towing company that conducts business 24in the State; 25(viii) a representative of the automobile insurance industry in the State; 2627(ix) a representative of local law enforcement agencies in the 28State;

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1 (g) The Commission shall submit a report of its findings and 2 recommendations to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State 3 Government Article, the General Assembly as follows:

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(1) an interim report on or before December 31, 2010; and

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(2) a final report on or before December 31, 2011.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 June 1, 2010. It shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and, at the end of May 31, 8 2012, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be 9 abrogated and of no further force and effect.
