A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Commercial Law – Attachment of Contract Payments Due from or Payable by**
3 **the State, a Local Governing Body, or a Public Officer**

4 FOR the purpose of providing that a contract payment due from or payable by the
5 State or a local governing body, or by the public officers of the State or a local
6 governing body, to a person is subject to a certain attachment process brought
7 for the enforcement of certain legal obligations of the person; and generally
8 relating to the attachment of contract payments.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Commercial Law**

18 Subtitle 6. Attachment of Wages AND CONTRACT PAYMENTS.

19 **15–608.**

20 A CONTRACT PAYMENT, DUE FROM OR PAYABLE BY THE STATE OR A
21 LOCAL GOVERNING BODY, OR BY THE PUBLIC OFFICERS OF THE STATE OR A
22 LOCAL GOVERNING BODY, TO A PERSON IS SUBJECT TO THE ATTACHMENT
23 PROCESS BROUGHT FOR THE ENFORCEMENT OF THE PRIVATE LEGAL
24 OBLIGATIONS OF THE PERSON IN THE SAME MANNER AND TO THE SAME EXTENT

1 AS IF THE STATE OR LOCAL GOVERNING BODY, AND THE PUBLIC OFFICERS OF
2 THE STATE OR LOCAL GOVERNING BODY, WERE A PRIVATE PERSON.

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
4 October 1, 2010.
