#### A BILL ENTITLED

#### 1 AN ACT concerning

# State Police Retirement System – Special Disability Retirement Allowance Forfeiture

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting certain members or former members of the State  $\mathbf{5}$ Police Retirement System who commit certain criminal offenses during a 6 certain period of time from applying for a certain disability retirement 7 allowance; requiring the Board of Trustees of the State Retirement and Pension 8 System to temporarily suspend the application process for a certain disability 9 retirement allowance if the member or former member applying for the certain 10 disability retirement allowance has committed certain criminal offenses during a certain period of time; requiring the Board of Trustees to temporarily suspend 11 12a certain disability retirement allowance of certain disability retirees of the 13State Police Retirement System if the disability retirees commit certain 14criminal offenses during a certain period of time; requiring the Board of 15Trustees to permanently terminate a certain disability application process of 16certain members or former members if certain convictions of certain criminal 17 offenses have been upheld; requiring the Board of Trustees to permanently terminate the payment of a certain disability retirement allowance of certain 18 19disability retirees if certain convictions of certain criminal offenses have been 20upheld; providing that certain members or former members may apply for a 21certain disability retirement allowance or resume the application process for a 22certain disability retirement allowance if a certain verdict on certain criminal 23offenses is rendered; providing that certain disability retirees may resume 24receipt of a certain disability retirement allowance if a certain verdict on certain 25criminal offenses is rendered; requiring the Secretary of State Police to report 26certain information to the Board of Trustees; requiring the Board of Trustees to 27take certain actions immediately after receiving certain information from the 28Secretary of State Police; defining a certain term; and generally relating to 29members, former members, and disability retirees of the State Police 30 Retirement System forfeiting certain rights to a special disability retirement 31allowance following the conviction of criminal offenses.

10 SUBTITLE 2 OF THE CRIMINAL LAW ARTICLE; OR

(16) THE COMMON LAW CRIME OF MISCONDUCT IN OFFICE.

12 (B) (1) (I) IF A MEMBER OR FORMER MEMBER OF THE STATE 13 POLICE RETIREMENT SYSTEM PLEADS GUILTY, NO DEFENSE, OR RECEIVES A 14 PROBATION BEFORE JUDGMENT TO A CRIMINAL OFFENSE, THE MEMBER OR 15 FORMER MEMBER MAY NOT APPLY FOR A SPECIAL DISABILITY RETIREMENT 16 UNDER § 29–103 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

17 (II) IF A MEMBER OR FORMER MEMBER OF THE STATE 18 POLICE RETIREMENT SYSTEM HAS APPLIED FOR A SPECIAL DISABILITY 19 RETIREMENT UNDER § 29–103 OF THIS SUBTITLE BEFORE PLEADING GUILTY, 20 NO DEFENSE, OR RECEIVING A PROBATION BEFORE JUDGMENT TO A CRIMINAL 21 OFFENSE, THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES SHALL TEMPORARILY SUSPEND THE 22 MEMBER'S OR FORMER MEMBER'S DISABILITY APPLICATION PROCESS.

23(2) STATE IF A DISABILITY RETIREE OF THE POLICE **RETIREMENT SYSTEM RECEIVING A SPECIAL DISABILITY RETIREMENT** 2425ALLOWANCE PLEADS GUILTY, NO DEFENSE, OR RECEIVES A PROBATION BEFORE JUDGMENT TO A CRIMINAL OFFENSE, THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES SHALL 26TEMPORARILY SUSPEND THE DISABILITY RETIREE'S SPECIAL DISABILITY 2728**RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE.** 

29 (C) (1) A MEMBER OR FORMER MEMBER OF THE STATE POLICE 30 RETIREMENT SYSTEM IS SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (B)(1) OF THIS SECTION IF 31 THE MEMBER OR FORMER MEMBER COMMITS A CRIMINAL OFFENSE AT ANY 32 TIME DURING THE PERIOD OF TIME THE MEMBER OR FORMER MEMBER IS 33 EMPLOYED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE. 1 (2) A DISABILITY RETIREE OF THE STATE POLICE RETIREMENT 2 SYSTEM RECEIVING A SPECIAL DISABILITY RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE IS 3 SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (B)(2) OF THIS SECTION IF THE DISABILITY RETIREE 4 COMMITTED A CRIMINAL OFFENSE AT ANY TIME DURING THE PERIOD OF TIME 5 THE DISABILITY RETIREE WAS EMPLOYED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE 6 POLICE.

7 (D) ON ENTRY OF A PLEA OF GUILTY OR NO DEFENSE OR ON INITIAL 8 CONVICTION OF A CRIMINAL OFFENSE, A DISABILITY RETIREE OF THE STATE 9 POLICE RETIREMENT SYSTEM MAY NOT RECEIVE ANY PAYMENT OR PARTIAL 10 PAYMENT OF THE DISABILITY RETIREE'S SPECIAL DISABILITY RETIREMENT 11 ALLOWANCE DURING THE PENDENCY OF AN APPEAL.

12 (E) (1) THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES SHALL PERMANENTLY TERMINATE 13 ANY SPECIAL DISABILITY RETIREMENT APPLICATION PROCESS OF A MEMBER 14 OR FORMER MEMBER OF THE STATE POLICE RETIREMENT SYSTEM, IF ALL 15 APPEALS HAVE BEEN EXHAUSTED UPHOLDING THE MEMBER'S OR FORMER 16 MEMBER'S CONVICTION OF A CRIMINAL OFFENSE.

17 (2) (I) AFTER ALL APPEALS HAVE BEEN EXHAUSTED 18 UPHOLDING A STATE POLICE RETIREMENT SYSTEM DISABILITY RETIREE'S 19 CONVICTION OF A CRIMINAL OFFENSE, THE DISABILITY RETIREE'S SPECIAL 20 DISABILITY RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE SHALL BE FORFEITED.

21 (II) IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS 22 PARAGRAPH, THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES SHALL PERMANENTLY CEASE ALL 23 PAYMENTS OF ANY SPECIAL DISABILITY RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE TO A 24 DISABILITY RETIREE.

(F) IF A VERDICT OF NOT GUILTY IS RENDERED OR THE INDICTMENT OR
 CRIMINAL INFORMATION FINALLY DISMISSED, THEN:

(1) (I) A MEMBER OR FORMER MEMBER OF THE STATE POLICE
 RETIREMENT SYSTEM MAY APPLY FOR A SPECIAL DISABILITY RETIREMENT
 ALLOWANCE UNDER § 29–103 OF THIS SUBTITLE; OR

(II) THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES SHALL RESUME THE
 APPLICATION PROCESS FOR A SPECIAL DISABILITY RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE
 OF A MEMBER OR FORMER MEMBER OF THE STATE POLICE RETIREMENT
 SYSTEM; OR

34(2) A DISABILITY RETIREE OF THE STATE POLICE RETIREMENT35SYSTEM SHALL BE ENTITLED TO ALL BENEFITS INCLUDING THOSE THAT36ACCRUED DURING THE PERIOD OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION, IF ANY.

1 (G) (1) THE SECRETARY OF STATE POLICE SHALL REPORT TO THE 2 BOARD OF TRUSTEES ANY MEMBER, FORMER MEMBER, OR DISABILITY RETIREE 3 OF THE STATE POLICE RETIREMENT SYSTEM WHO IS CONVICTED, PLEADS 4 GUILTY OR NO DEFENSE, OR RECEIVES A PROBATION BEFORE JUDGMENT TO A 5 CRIMINAL OFFENSE AT ANY TIME WHILE EMPLOYED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF 6 STATE POLICE.

7 (2) AFTER RECEIVING NOTICE FROM THE SECRETARY OF STATE 8 POLICE UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE BOARD OF 9 TRUSTEES SHALL IMMEDIATELY:

10 (I) PROHIBIT THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION OF A
11 DISABILITY RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE BY A REPORTED MEMBER OR FORMER
12 MEMBER;

13(II)TEMPORARILY SUSPEND ANY APPLICATION PROCESS OF14A REPORTED MEMBER OR FORMER MEMBER; OR

15 (III) TEMPORARILY SUSPEND ANY SPECIAL DISABILITY
16 RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE BENEFIT PAYMENT OF A REPORTED DISABILITY
17 RETIREE.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect19 July 1, 2010.
