State Board of Dental Examiners – Written Notification of Risk of Trigeminal Neuralgia

- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring a licensed dentist to provide a patient with written 5 notice each time the licensed dentist performs a dental procedure that has the 6 risk of resulting in trigeminal neuralgia; authorizing a patient to submit a 7 certain complaint to the State Board of Dental Examiners under certain 8 circumstances; requiring the Board to investigate a certain complaint and take 9 disciplinary action against a licensed dentist under certain circumstances; authorizing the Board to adopt regulations to carry out a certain provision of 10 law; and generally relating to written notification of the risk of trigeminal 11 12 neuralgia by licensed dentists.

- 22 (A) A LICENSED DENTIST SHALL PROVIDE A PATIENT WITH WRITTEN 23 NOTIFICATION EACH TIME THE LICENSED DENTIST PERFORMS A DENTAL
- 24 PROCEDURE ON THE PATIENT THAT HAS THE RISK OF RESULTING IN
- 25 TRIGEMINAL NEURALGIA.

 9 THIS SECTION.
- 10 **(D)** THE BOARD MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS 11 SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2010.
